

#### What to expect

From there, your Safe Babies Safe Moms care team will help you schedule follow-up appointments for prenatal and postpartum care, as well as legal counseling and mental health care if needed. The team will also help you find your child a pediatrician or family medicine provider and help get you appointments when the time is right.
