The SuperH[™] race was created by Harry (SuperH[™]) and Renie Freedman after Harry sustained a serious workplace accident requiring the amputation of his leg. Harry and Renie have been dedicated to raising money for our Adaptive Sports and Fitness Program at MedStar National Rehabilitation Hospital ever since.

This year marks the 22nd anniversary! With your support, SuperH™ has raised more than \$1 million for our Adaptive Sports and Fitness Program. It has become their mission to share with others the same kind of encouragement and support Harry received.

This year, we are looking to raise \$130,000 to ensure athletes can fully participate in inclusive sports completely free of charge.

The Adaptive Sports and Fitness Program is dedicated to empowering individuals with disabilities to embrace active, healthy lifestyles through both recreational and competitive sports. We strongly believe that everyone deserves the chance to participate! Our inclusive programs welcome members of the community with physical disabilities at no cost to them with comprehensive support: coaching, training, equipment, and travel assistance across eight weekly sports. Additionally, we organize competitive adaptive sports tournaments, junior camps, and special events throughout the year.

Both junior and adult participants—along with their families—discover a wealth of opportunities and resources. Held at accessible venues, our programs foster self-confidence, forge enduring personal connections, enhance overall health and wellbeing, promote greater independence and, above all, ensure a fun-filled experience for all athletes.

Highlights:

- We celebrate the remarkable achievements of Trevon Jenifer, who represented our program at the 2024 Paris Paralympic Games in basketball, serving as a beacon of inspiration with his exceptional talent.
- Our Division 1 basketball team finished second in the country, proudly competing for the national title.
- Our junior sled hockey team finished third at the 2024 Sled National Championships, showcasing the program's excellence.
- The wheelchair rugby team attended a record number of tournaments in the 2023 to 2024 season. Two athletes also attended Team USA wheelchair rugby training camps last year, representing our program on the national stage.



Our successful hosting of wheelchair rugby, wheelchair basketball, and wheelchair tennis tournaments, along with our annual junior camps highlight our commitment to providing enriching experiences for all participants.

SuperH™ is also creating challenges and activities throughout the virtual race week to make the event fun and engaging. Details will be shared on our social media networks and website.


